Immigration Resources

The U.S. Supreme Court ruled in *Plyler vs. Doe* that undocumented children and young adults have the same right to attend public primary and secondary schools as do U.S. citizens and permanent residents. Therefore, just like other children in Utah, undocumented students are required to attend school until they reach 18 years old.

Given the recent federal changes regarding immigration policies, we've assembled this list of resources to help educators work to ensure that a student's right to an education is not undermined by federal immigration enforcement and to protect children from possible dangers such as human trafficking and abandonment. The resources in this list may be useful to families facing deportation and separation. This list has been shared with school administrators and staff and may be made available to families.

The first section includes general information and resources, along with a link to an English PDF and a Spanish PDF about parental rights when facing deportation. These PDFs may be printed and shared with families, as appropriate.

The second section includes information from the Utah Immigrant Advocacy Coalition about how to set up a family emergency plan. This is a plan that would allow parents to designate a temporary guardian for their children if the parent is detained. The English and Spanish PDFs may be printed and shared with families, as appropriate. (We have not found these in other languages yet.) These plans must be notarized to be valid.

The third section has links for local legal resources, and the fourth section is a link to all the embassies and consulates in Salt Lake City, including contact information (click on each country name to get to the contact info). The last section is a "Know Your Rights" section with links to PDFs in many languages.
